Summary of Duties and Responsibility:

- Patient fitting and instruction on use and protocol of Continuous Passive Motion devices (CPM's)
- Patient fitting and instruction on Durable Medical Equipment (DME)
- Orthopedic bracing to control, guide, limit and/or immobilize an extremity, joint or body segment for a particular diagnosis or procedure
- Daily communication with patients via phone/in-person
- Daily scheduling of patient's in-home setup appointments and rental equipment pickup
- Daily cleaning of patient rental equipment
- Resolve patients' technical issues
- Accuracy in obtaining and confirming patient information
- Perform all necessary daily paperwork (i.e. patient setup reports, managing referrals, appointment times, and treatment plan forms)
- Present insurance financial policies and arrangements accurately to patients
